# THE COMPANY



After many years working separately, individually and in companies like Voala Project, El Fedito, Lucas Locus, La Débarde, Cuca da Ilum and El Circópodo, the 5 members of the company decided to work together on the same line, forming La Trócola Circus company.

A feature of these artists is their admiration for performing arts, its constant attempt to renew ideas, investigate and implement them, which always makes an innovative approach as a result of its work, with a clear seal of La Trócola.

In early 2012 the company is created, since then they have created short numbers with which they participated in different festivals and circus conventions in Turkey, Hungary and Castellón, the festival of street performers Art en Bitrir, the festival much more May, the contest "Que arte tienes" and galas organized by the circus association Donyet Ardit of Alicante.

Currently displaying new work, a medium-format 35 minutes street show, which is based on the investigation of objects, the movement and the creation of structures, co-directed by Lucas Escobedo (Lucas Locus) and Antonio Segura Lizán (Cía Akoreacro).

Their intention is to bring to stage a show of high technical level, in which attention is paid to every detail always trying to surprise and captivate the viewer. But technique is not the only thing in this show, as the object research, its versatility and creativity of la Trócola team, led them in this creation to cross boundaries and explore new dimensions.



# THE SHOW

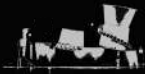
The Potted project based on the premise of artistic innovation. The four members of the company, come together with the interest of creating a unique and original show, based on the research of space, objects, structures and rhythm.

The intention is to put in crisis the direction of the object to reach its essence, through circus disciplines, creating a direct communication with the audience, full of great visual impact.



This ambitious and different proposal, seeks common points between: sculptural harmony and chaos, static and dynamic, artificial and organic, gravity and weightlessness, the boundaries of the object and people, and the unlimited ... all it on stage, in the form of entertainment, visual poetry. # TECHNICAL RIDER

- DURATION: 35 minutes
- SET UP TIME: 4 hours
- TAKE DOWN TIME: 1 hour
- LOUNGE REQUIREMENTS:
  - Smooth, compact, homogenous, and regular floor
  - MINIMUM stage measures:
    - Width: 10 m
    - Length: 8 m
    - Height: 6 m
- SOUND: 2000w sound system
- LIGHTING: if the show is at night, consult the Company
- Dressing room with toilet, mirror and shower
- Car park for a van close to the stage.
- In summer do not program between 12am and 7pm directly under the sun
- Failure to meet any of this features, consult the Company, because there could be the possibility of not being able to make the show
