THE COMPANY

La Trócola Circ is a circus company that bases its productions on research with objects. From a clear commitment to innovation, they explore and stage different languages.

With their first production that made them known, *Potted*, they have worked in the main national and international venues and festivals. *Potted* is still on tour due to its great acclaim, so far more than 200 shows complete their tour.

In 2017 they created their second production, *Emportats.* The intention was to continue with their label, presenting a show with a high technical level, well-structured and well-planned. Added to the versatility and decontextualization of the object is live music, provided by two new artists belonging to the band, Jo & SwissKnife.

This gave way to *Emportats* receiving the award for Best Show at Feten Nights 2018, Best Circus Show of the Valencian Community, Audience Award at the International Strassentheater Festival Ludwigshafen, and were candidates for the MAX Awards as revelation show. In addition, La Trócola Circ was awarded for the Contribution to the Performing Arts of the Valencian Community in the 2019 Estruch Awards granted by the Juan Gil-Albert Alicante Institute of Culture of the Alicante Provincial Council and the Principal Theater of Alicante.

After more than 250 performances with *Emportats* and 10 years since the company's start, they decide to carry out their third creation, presenting *R.E.M.* in May 2023. *R.E.M.* is a work that maintains the investigation of objects, but immerses itself in an elaborate dramaturgy. The work talks about dreams through live scenery, on this occasion, 4 beds.







THE SHOW

TEASER

When we sleep, the body connects us with our desires, our fears and our hopes. We dream.

R.E.M. is a trip to the world of dreams - a reflection and an investigation of objects in a circus setting for all audiences that weaves a dream story sown with our own concerns. *R.E.M.* talks about the demands of one's self, borders and the fear of failing. It is a call to courage, to achieve what we long for or at least to try.

4 artists and 4 beds become the driving material of dreams through juggling in heights, handstands, acrobatics, banquine and hand to hand - 4 beats that multiply with each sigh of the audience in the stalls.

R.E.M. proposes to daydream with a surprising, fun and moving journey with which La Trócola Circ once again sets the stage for life in motion.
